

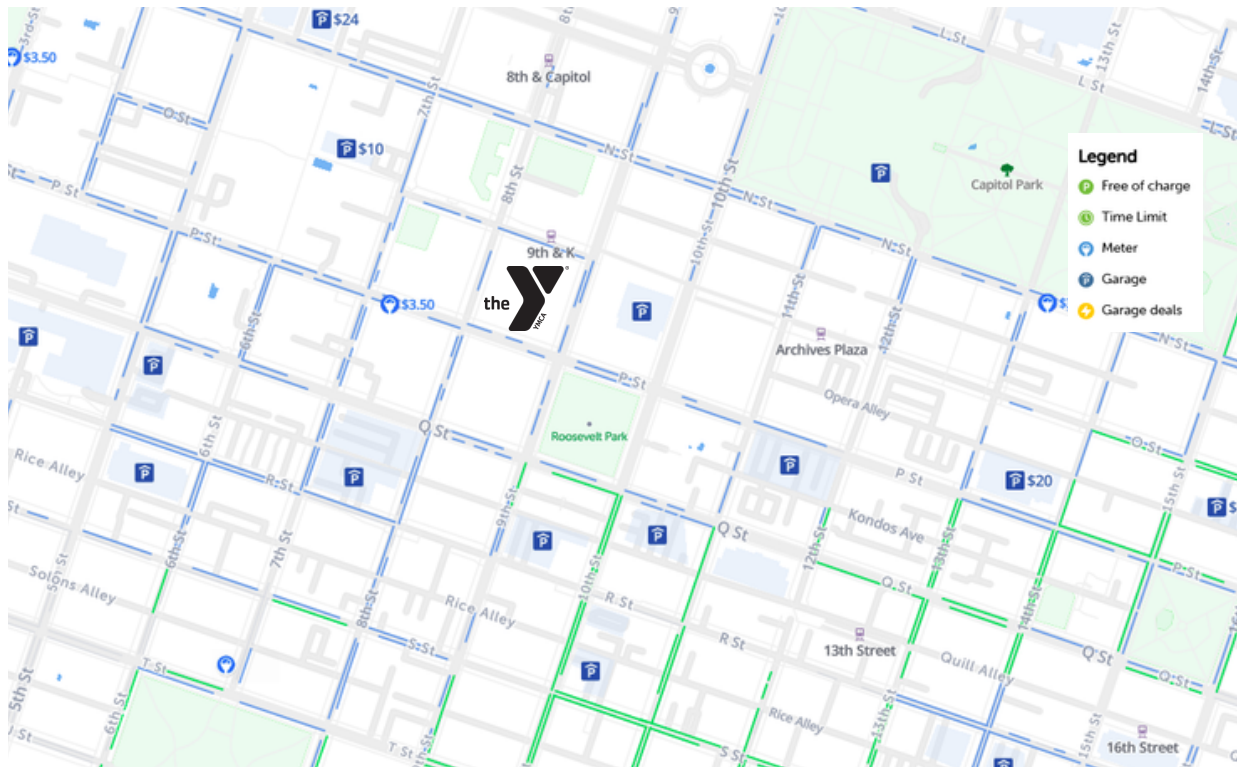
The Capital YMCA Transportation Guide



PARKING:

If you plan to drive to the Capital YMCA, you have some options!

- Free Street Parking– It does exist! See all green lines for free all day parking.
- Free Street Parking– Available before 8:00am and all-day on weekends, making these times an excellent choice for finding a parking spot. Please check the signage for any time restrictions.
- Parking Garage– Several parking garages are located near the Capital YMCA building. See map legend.
- The best times to find parking in downtown Sacramento are weekdays after 4:30 pm and throughout the weekends.
- The City Hall Garage offers a rate of \$1.50 per half hour, making it an affordable option for extended parking.
- ParkMobile App– The ParkMobile app is a game-changer for parking in downtown.
 - The Parking Availability tool for locating open parking spaces and a map view displaying available parking spots within the vicinity, finding parking has never been easier.
 - You can reserve and pay for your parking spot on the app. Just enter the ParkMobile zone number and location information from the meter decal or zone sign.
 - The app allows you to extend your parking time remotely, right from your mobile device.



We look forward to seeing you at the Capital YMCA! Whether you drive or take public transportation, we are easily accessible Downtown, and ready to welcome you.

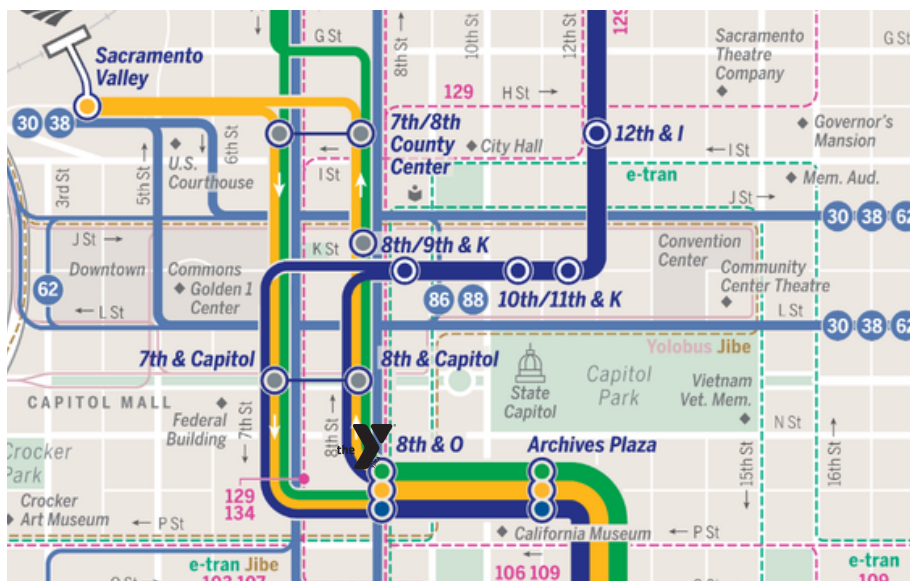
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PUBLIC TRANSIT:

Consider using public transportation, there are several convenient options!

- SacRT provides rides downtown via bus or light rail/train.
 - A SacRT train station is located directly across the street from the YMCA. Members can take the Blue, Green, or Gold line and get off at the 8th & O Station to visit us.
 - A bus station (Downtown/8th & O) is located directly outside the front door of the YMCA. Members can take the local bus service (51, 62) to arrive at our location.
 - Offering Daily, weekly or month passes, with discounts for seniors and students.
- Easy ways to travel with SacRT
 - Connect Transit Card: electronic transit fare payment system. You can now purchase your transit fare online, manage on your phone, and use the card on more than one agency.
 - Transit Connect App: Allowing you to manage your passes, find stops, and more.
